#### **School Uniform**

Pupils must arrive and depart in school uniform or, if Sixth Form, appropriate clothes. If school matches have been played, <u>full</u> tracksuits may be worn for the journey home.

The complete school uniform can be found in the school uniform list. Below is a summary of some key points.

- Shirts/blouses to be tucked in with ties at the appropriate length. When wearing tie, top button should be done up.
- Any tights worn should be up to 100 denier and natural or black.
- Skirt length should be on the knee. No rolling at the waist.
- Years 10 & 11- may wear low-chunky heeled shoes only (max. heel 2 inches).
- Long hair should be tied back with a navy, black or uniform tartan band/scrunchie and off the face. Boys hair to be no longer than collar length and off the face. Girls in Year 11 can wear hair partly down.
- Hairstyles including braiding and/or hair colouring should be in keeping with the image and ethos of the school, and the school reserves the right to request that these are changed if deemed inappropriate.
- No hair colouring is allowed before Year 9, and only natural colours hereafter.
- Only Year 9 upwards can wear subtle make-up. No false eyelashes.
- For health and safety reasons nail art, nail extensions, polish is not permitted. Jewellery unless for religious reasons is not permitted including rings, bracelets, necklaces and charity bands.
- Pierced ears may only wear a single stud in the lower lobe of each ear. No other visible piercings allowed.
- Avoid self-tanning products as often it looks streaky.
- Uniform must be labelled clearly to allow lost items to be found and returned promptly.
